1. Spinners will spin for 30 minutes.
2. The yarn will be skeined and entered into one of the following classes:
3. All skeins will be measured for longest skein and judged for best overall skein in all divisions.
4. Contestants may enter only one division
5. Contestants must bring their own spinning wheel or drop spindle. (A limited number of drop spindles will be available for purchase during the workshop)
6. Carded wool will be provided.
7. Contestants are also encouraged to bring a niddy-noddy for skeining finished yarn.

The Central Florida Fair Wool Show is presented to encourage the production of better wool and provide an opportunity for producers and the public to learn more about the qualities of wool.

Rules:

1. The exhibitor may or may not own the sheep at the time of shearing.
2. Fleece must have been shorn in current year.
3. Fleece will be judged on hand spinning quality, should be skirted.
4. Fleece should be tied with paper twine, flesh side out and tagged with number of months grown.
5. Natural colored fleeces must have at least 35 percent colored fibers.
6. All fleeces must be delivered to the Central Florida Fair Sheep Office, Thursday, April 24, 2008 from 7:00-8:00 p.m.
7. Fleeces will be released Saturday, April 26, 2008 at 10:00 PM
